Growth & height, skull, circumference change	Assessment of growth (Parameter at birth, Development weight, Important Milestone, Sexual maturation, Behavioral problems (Enuresis, Stammering etc.)
Nutrition Energy and nutrient requirements (with age),	Vitamins (Sources, amount required deficiency), Kwashiorkor, Marasmus,
Newborn	Assessment of maturity (signs, reflexes). Prematurity, IUGR, GAR score, Hyperbilirubinemia, Resp. distress syndrome, Congenital malformation.
Hematology	Anaemias (Iron deficiency, Megaloblastic, Aplastic, Hemolytic), Sickle Cell anemia, Thalassemia, Purpura, Hemophilia,
Immunity requirement	Immune deficiency, Immunization, Infections (TB, Malaria, Leprosy, Diphtheria, Polio, Typhoid), Fluid & Blood
GIT	Congenital lesions (Pyloric stenosis, hiatus hernia, anal atresia, Hirschsprung's disease), Cystic fibrosis, Indian Childhood Cirrhosis, Hepatosplenomegaly.
CVS	Congenital lesions (Cyanotic & Acyanotic), CHF, rheumatic fever, Hypertension, Pericarditis, Normal changes with age
Respiratory Tract	Wheezing stridor, Dyspnoea, Asthma, Bronchiolitis, Bronchiectasis, Common pneumonia's Lung Function Tests.
UTI	Renal Physiology (Function Tests), GN, PN, Nephrotic syndrome, Hemolytic uremic syndrome ARF, CRF
CNS	Meningitis, Rye's syndrome (Tubererculomas), Epilepsies, Cerebral Palsy, Mental retardation, Myopathies, Juvenile Rheumatoid arthritis.
